



NATO Adds More of Coastal's Weather Stations to Network

Coastal received a contract for 6 more weather stations to be used by NATO/OTAN. Coastal designs and builds the weather stations then ships them to Larcet Srl, Coastal's Italian Representative. Larcet adds the power supply and protection components and then delivers the systems to an Air Traffic Management integrator named Selex Sistemi, who in turn provides an air traffic control system to a larger defense contractor, Finmeccania. Here the weather systems are then completed and supplied to NATO/OTAN.

NATO will use the completed systems in conjunction with radar to monitor military and commercial air traffic in Europe.

Along with Coastal's custom manufacturing additions, Larcet Srl, will be adding some electrical and mechanical components to the systems in order to be fully compliant with Selex and NATO's exact specifications.
